**O R D E R**

On this **29<sup>th</sup>** day of **September, 2022**, comes on for hearing the matter of an emergency ban on all burning in Ashley County, and it is found as follows:

1. This order is an emergency order issued under the powers inherent in this Court.
2. Effective immediately, a burn ban is issued for Ashley County.
3. Due to dry conditions and extreme fire hazards, all persons in Ashley County are directed to refrain from all outdoor and open burning, grilling, and shooting or discharging any type of fireworks, until further notice.
4. This Court will lift the burn ban only upon written order after weather and moisture conditions permit.
5. The cooperation of everyone in Ashley County is urgently needed to prevent destruction and injury by outdoor fires during this dangerous period.
6. Violators will be reported for filing of appropriate charges.
